

RULES FOR RETURNING TO WORK AFTER COVID-RELATED ABSENCES

ISOLATION AND SELF-SURVEILLANCE (circular no. 37615 - Ministry of Health - of 31/08/2022)

Update of 14/11/2022

COVID contagion prevention rules in force since 08/31/2022 provide that isolation can end after at least 5 days if a subject has been asymptomatic for at least 2 days and an antigenic or molecular test proved negative. **In the event of persistent positivity, isolation can be interrupted at the end of the 14th day from the first positive swab, regardless of testing.**

TO RETURN TO WORK PEOPLE WHO TESTED POSITIVE FOR COVID must complete the isolation required by current provisions, communicate to their manager and transmit to the infirmary (covid.infermeria@fondazione.lascale.it) the certificate of end Isolation or alternatively the negative result of a molecular or rapid antigen swab (only people in the red group need to wait for authorization to return in Theatre).

PEOPLE IN THE RED GROUP who have had SARS CoV2 infection will be able to resume work without a mask only after a negative result of a molecular or a third generation antigenic swab performed at the end of the isolation period required by law. **After the period of isolation with rapid negative swab, if the General Practitioner defines the absence for illness, the artist will perform a third generation swab at the Theater Infirmary before resuming activities without a mask; in the event of a positive result, he/she will be sent to the control with a molecular swab and in the meantime will only be able to continue the activities that allow the use of a mask or, if this were not possible for example for wind instruments, an interpersonal distance of at least 2 meters.**

The way and the schedule of return to work of the people in the red group will be certified by the Competent Physician of the Theatre to the single person concerned and to the inspector of reference after verification of the performed tests.

PEOPLE WHO HAD SEVERE COVID DISEASE OR HAVE BEEN HOSPITALIZED, before returning to work must request a visit to the Competent Physician of the Theatre, request to be made by the inspector of reference to the infirmary.

CONTACTS WITH COVID CASES

(the indications contained in Circular No. 19680 of 30/03/2022 are still in force)

Those who had close contact with confirmed SARS-CoV-2 positive subjects, must apply a self-monitoring regime, consisting in the obligation to wear FFP2 respiratory protection devices, both indoors and in presence of gatherings, **up to 10th day following the date of the last close contact**, and to perform a rapid or molecular antigen test at the first appearance of symptoms.

PEOPLE OF THE RED GROUP (choir, ballet, winds and other artists who do not use the mask) WHO HAVE BEEN CLOSE CONTACT must report it to the infirmary and during the 10-day self-monitoring period carry out a third generation antigen test every day they perform artistic activities without a mask.
